- The same flame they had from the beginning shall continue to remain, grow and flourish.
- Any struggles faced and the resulting experiences will be used to better their marriage and each individual spouse.
- All marriages will be guided by the Holy Spirit, and each spouse shall be guided by the Holy Spirit individually also.
- May spouses first turn to God when struggling, but also be vulnerable with their spouses.
- May they not turn to other people or things outside of their marriage for relief.
- Spouses shall be a source of love and relief for one another.
- They will keep an open line of communication, honesty, and trust.
- Husbands and wives will be slow to anger in heated discussions, and each spouse shall intentionally listen to one another before speaking or preparing to speak.
- Spouses shall follow all standards given in Colossians three.
- Their marriages shall last for the remainder of their lives on earth.
- Your marriage shall remain healthy, and you will allow your successful marriage to set an example and positively impact your children and all who witness it.
- We speak against any attacks of the enemy against your marriage and we bind it now in Jesus' name.
- Marriages shall be bless with however many children God has predestined them to care for, and all children shall be born on time and healthy. We speak against miscarriages, premature births, stillbirths, and premature deaths now in the name of Jesus.
- Stepparents shall get along with their spouse's children and shall be respected by them.
- In the name of Jesus, your marriage is blessed and not cursed.

- We pray that those who have come in between someone else's marriage in the past be forgiven and not reap what they have sown by the grace and mercy of God in Jesus' name.
- Work, children, family, or other responsibilities shall not come in between quality time.
- Family and friends shall respect your spouses and be quickly reproved when stepping out of line.
- Your marriage and household shall be financially stable.
- Both husband and wife shall use wisdom in financial, familial, and household affairs.
- Finances or arguments regarding finances will not cause conflict or come in between your marriage.
- Your love shall not recede for one another. Instead, it will grow more and more each day.
- You will treat each other with God's love.
- Spouses shall continue to desire each other and each other only.
- Neither husbands nor wives will struggle with sexual perversion, and they will limit their sex life and sexual activities to and with each other.
